CARB (California Air Regulation Board) instituted mandatory controls of formaldehyde levels in several manufactured wood products. As of January 2010, plywood style wood flooring is required to have formaldehyde emissions lower than 0.05ppm as part of this certification.

All of our engineered wood flooring products have met the emissions (Phase 2) requirements and are CARB-ATCM Certified by a CARB-approved Third Party Certifier.
